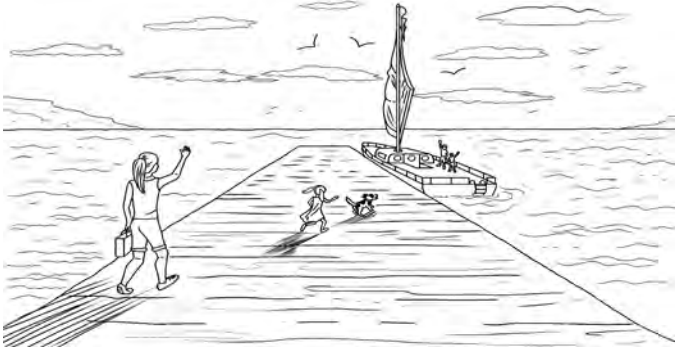

mom when she is in need. But she has no cash left on her for the mint gum. She sets the gum back on the shelf.

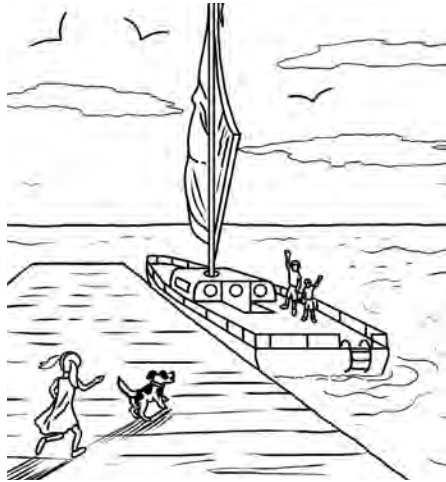
“Oh, well,” she thinks. “I will get the gum next time.”
